## **Upcoming Events & News (con't)**

#### **Highlights Council Meeting Held March 5**

- 1. Church Visitors Rev. Nate V and George F joined the meeting for an annual visit. A report will be issued and sent to Redeemer once completed.
- 2. Pastor Corey V gave an annual review of Redeemer Online (ROL). There are 800 subscribers to the ROL channel presently, representing a wide demographic. Motion made and carried to approve a 3% cost of living increase for Corey, as well as a move to full time compensation should funds become available. It was noted that funds for ROL are wholly independent of Redeemer CRC, who provides oversight only.
- 3. Meeting held between the councils of the three Sarnia CRC's in order to discuss working together.
- 4. Motion made and carried to approve amended memorandum of understanding (MOU) between Resonate and Redeemer. The MOU reflects an increase to 8 hours a week that Pastor Joe provides to Resonate. The hours compliment Pastor Joe's work at Redeemer and do not translate to a substantial increase to his work load.
- 5. Motion made and carried to approve a 5% increase to rental rates as of April 1, 2024. The rates have remained the same since 2019.
- 6. Congregation will be invited to nominate members for Council. There are three council members retiring this spring. two Elders and one Deacon.
